Notes:

1. The curriculum is divided into four categories: **Core Courses in English Language Teaching, Elective Courses in English Language Teaching, Language and Literature, and Research Methods and Thesis.**
2. A total of **30 credits** is required for graduation, including **3 credits of required courses** and **27 credits of elective courses**. The required coursework includes **6 credits in Core Courses in English Language Teaching, 12 credits in Elective Courses in English Language Teaching, 6 credits in Language and Literature, and 6 credits in Research Methods and Thesis. Thesis Research**, which carries **0 credits**, is not included in the graduation credit requirement.
3. During the **first academic year**, students must take no fewer than **6 credits per semester**. During the **second academic year**, students must take no fewer than **3 credits per semester**. This requirement does not apply to students who have already completed all required coursework credits.
4. With the approval of the Department, students may take up to **6 credits of elective courses offered by other graduate institutes or universities**. Such courses must be **taught in English**.
(Applicable to students admitted in Academic Year 110 and thereafter.)
5. For the Department courses **Research Methods—Qualitative Research** and **Research Methods—Quantitative Research**, only credits earned from courses **taught in English** will be recognized. Moreover, such courses should be offered by the College of Education at NTHU under the course codes KHCT5001 and KHCT5002.
